Subject: Grant application to the Prescott-Russell Community Development Corporation (PRCDC)

### Recommendation

Whereas the Council wants to assure a good quality of life to its community for the future years, and;

Whereas a vision of sustainable development in the medium and long term is essential.

Be it resolved that a grant application be submitted to the PRCDC, as recommended in document 2019\_REC\_70.

### Explanation, history, context

The Council must continue to ensure sustainable and harmonious development while showing vision, which will make our Town a good place to live.

In order to meet a defined need within a reasonable time, many important projects deserve to be addressed. To do this, hiring four project managers is required.

The first project would consist of the development of the Chenail Island and the eastern shoreline.

The second project would involve the development of an urban farm in the James, Portelance and Taché borough, the development of a plan and the establishment of forest canopy objectives.

The third project would revitalize Main Street, Pioneers' Park and make the Town's entrances more welcoming, as part of the Welcoming Francophone Community initiative, by way of facade renovation and storefront window styling for example.

The fourth project would be the creation of a smart enterprise databank (data hub) and artificial intelligence, including digital language learning for young people and adults, and everything related to digital and robotic technology.

At the top of the project pyramid, project managers will have to oversee the projects, ensure they are carried out and manage their progress.
