BY-LAW N° 75-2024

A By-law to authorize the temporary closure of sidewalks within the Town of Hawkesbury

WHEREAS section 27(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* states that a municipality may pass by-laws in respect of a highway only if it has jurisdiction over the highway, and:

WHEREAS section 1(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* defines "*highway*" as a common and public highway and includes any bridge, trestle, viaduct or other structure forming part of the highway and, except as otherwise provided, includes a portion of a highway, and;

WHEREAS section 1(1) of *Ontario Regulation 239/02 Minimum Maintenance Standards* defines "*sidewalk*" as the part of the highway specifically set aside or commonly understood to be for pedestrian use, typically consisting of a paved surface but does not include crosswalks, medians, boulevards, shoulders or any part of the sidewalk where cleared snow has been deposited, and;

WHEREAS section 16.8 of *Ontario Regulation 239/02* states, *inter alia*, that when a municipality closes a highway or part of a highway pursuant to its powers under the Act, the highway is deemed to be in a state of repair in respect of all conditions described in this Regulation from the time of the closure until the highway is reopened by the municipality, and;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury deems it appropriate to temporarily close certain sidewalks during the winter season.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the sidewalks, pedestrian pathways and recreational lanes, all considered sidewalks under the *Ontario Regulation 239/02*, listed in Schedule "A" attached hereto be closed from November 1st of each year to April 30th of the next year following.
- 2. **THAT** By-law 15-2021 is hereby repealed.
- 3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its adoption.
