By-law N° 38-2019

A by-law to amend By-law N° 37-2004 for licencing, regulating and governing the owners and drivers of taxicabs and limousines

WHEREAS the Council wishes to amend the Taxi By-law to authorize the use of a spare vehicle when a taxicab licenced under this By-law is out of service.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Hawkesbury enacts as follows:

1. THAT the following section be added after section 7 of By-law N° 37-2004:

"7A TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT VEHICLES

- 7A.1 No person shall use a vehicle as a temporary replacement of a taxicab licenced under this By-law without respecting the following conditions:
 - Obtain written authorization from the Clerk to have a replacement vehicle;
 - Provide the Certificate of Mechanical Fitness under subsection 6.4 of this By-law;
 - Vehicle is subject to the frequency of inspections under subsection 6.5 of this By-law;
 - Vehicle is subject to life limit under subsection 6.9 of this Bylaw:
 - Vehicle shall be equipped with a taximeter and is subject to section 8 of this By-law;
 - Vehicle shall not display any permanent lettering except for a temporary decal that shall be removed once the licenced taxicab is back in service;
 - Taxi dome on replacement vehicle shall be removed once the licenced taxicab is back in service:
 - The annual licence fee under Schedule "A" shall be paid;
 - Licenced taxicab owner shall advise the By-law Enforcement Department prior to using a replacement vehicle and provide proof that the licenced taxicab is out-of-service.
- 7A.2 It shall be an offence to use a replacement vehicle without respecting the provisions of this section and any person who contravenes this section is guilty of an offence and penalty under section 16 of this By-law."
