Subject: Purchasing Policy Derogation re: Masonry Rehabilitation of the Maison de l'Ile

Recommendation

Whereas in 2018, the rehabilitation of the masonry of the north wall of the Maison de l'Ile was successfully undertaken, and:

Whereas Robertson Martin Architects was selected to supervise the project, and subcontracted John G. Cooke & Associates Ltd, an Engineering Consulting Firm specializing in Structural and Conservation Engineering, and;

Whereas Keystone Traditional Masonry Inc. was selected during a competitive bidding process to perform the stone repointing of the north wall, and;

Whereas rehabilitation of the masonry of the south was of the Maison de l'Ile was indicated as a priority and listed as a project in the 2019 budget, and;

Whereas the quote will only be available after the onsite meeting taking place on June 25, 2019.

Be it resolved that the Council deviate from the purchasing policy for the purpose of awarding a contract for the rehabilitation of the masonry of the south wall of the Maison de l'Ile to John G. Cooke & Associates and Keystone Traditional Masonry Inc. up to the maximum of \$165,000 as allocated in the 2019 budget, as recommended in document 2019-REC-53.

Explanation, history, context

In 2017, the Town hired Robertson Martin Architects, specialists in the rehabilitation of heritage buildings, to guide the Town in the rehabilitation work that is required for the Maison de l'Ile. In conjunction with John G. Cooke & Associates Ltd, it was established that all of the exterior walls of the building should be restored within the next 10 years, in the following priority: north wall, south wall, west wall, and east wall.

The north wall was completed in 2018, and the rehabilitation of the south was was included in the 2019 budget for a total of \$165,000.
