Explanation, history, context

We received a request from the Active Retirees' Fair organizers to display posters on municipal land at the corner of Cartier Boulevard and Spence Avenue, at the corner of Tupper and Main Street as well as on Cameron Street, between Aberdeen and Spence Avenue on the west side.

These posters will be displayed on existing signs that are currently used by our police department (see photo attached). Our Provincial Police Detachment Commander confirms that she allows the use of their posters for the above fair.

Posters will be removed at the end of the event. All the work would be carried out by the Active Retirees' Fair organizers, at no cost to the Municipality.
