Subject: Project 5G

Recommendation

Whereas the internet service provider IGS Hawkesbury wishes to install a 5G internet service in our community, and;

Whereas IGS Hawkesbury wishes to start with a pilot project to evaluate the development of the 5G network throughout the municipality, and;

Whereas IGS Hawkesbury is asking the Town's permission to install equipment on municipal property to evaluate the 5G service.

Be it resolved that Municipal Council authorize Chief Administrative Officer to reach an agreement with IGS Hawkesbury regarding a 5G internet service pilot project, as recommended in document 2019_REC_56.

Explanation, history, context

Mr Jamie Bogue's proposed project would allow taxpayers to have access to a more efficient and cost-effective internet service. At the same time, the service would help business owners and industries to stand out in their operations.

Mr Bogue is asking the Municipality to pay approximately \$2,500.00, half the cost of a new tower, if the existing tower does not meet their security needs. He would also like to be authorized to install posts for their network and is asking for storage in our municipal buildings.

If the Municipality accepts Mr Bogue's proposal, it will receive a wireless internet service at Old Mill Park and the same service for outdoor activities at the sports complex. At the final stage of the project, the Town of Hawkesbury will benefit from a wireless internet service throughout the municipality.

I recommend Municipal Council accept Mr Bogue's proposal at no cost to the Municipality.
